**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A50 Trunk Road (Sawley, Derbyshire) (Temporary  
Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

*Made - - - - 19th May 2014*

*Coming into force - - 26th May 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A50 Trunk Road (“the A50”) and connecting roads is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and two of those connecting roads, in Sawley, in the County of Derbyshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) , hereby makes the following Order: -

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A50 Trunk Road (Sawley, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 26th May 2014.

**2.** In this Order:

| “Sawley Interchange” | means the circulatory carriageway of the A50 at its junction with London Road, Tamworth Road, Rycroft Road and Trent Lane;  |
| “the trunk road”     | means –<br>a) the westbound carriageway of the A50 from its junction with Sawley Interchange, to its junction with the link road leading from the southbound carriageway of the A6;   |
| “a slip road”        | means the slip road leading –<br>a) to the westbound carriageway of the A50 from Sawley Interchange;<br>b) to the westbound carriageway of the A50 from Shardlow Services; and<br>c) to the westbound carriageway of the A50 from an unnamed road west of Sawley Interchange; |

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 2nd June 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
