ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A46 Trunk Road (West of Leicester, Leicestershire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - *19th May 2014*

Coming into force - - *26th May 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”), and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, and some of those connecting roads, west of Leicester, in the County of Leicestershire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (West of Leicester, Leicestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 26th May 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road”

means the –

- a) westbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with the slip road leading to the A50 roundabout, to its junction with the slip road leading from the A46 roundabout (M1 Junction 21a);
- b) eastbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with the slip road leading to the A46 roundabout (M1 Junction 21a), to its junction with the slip road leading from the A50 roundabout;
- c) westbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with the slip road leading to Rectory Road and the A6 roundabout, to its junction with the slip road leading from the A5630 Anstey Road and Gynsill Lane roundabout; and

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- d) eastbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with the slip road leading to the A5630 Anstey Road and Gynsill Lane roundabout, to its junction with the slip road leading from the A6 roundabout and Wanlip;

“a slip road” means any slip road leading to and from the trunk road;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 2nd June 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
