ROAD TRAFFIC

The M62 Motorway (Junction 22) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - 23rd January 2014

Coming into force - 2nd February 2014

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M62 Motorway and connecting roads, in the Districts of Calderdale and Kirklees, in the County of West Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because cattle grid replacement works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the M62 Motorway (Junction 22) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 2nd February 2014.

2. In this Order: –

“the M62” means the M62 Motorway;

“the slip road” means the M62 eastbound entry and westbound exit slips roads at Junction 22 (Windy Hill);

“overall width” has the meaning given in regulation 3(2) of the Road Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986(b);

“the first works period” means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 3rd February 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

“the second works period” means a period of:

(i) 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 3rd February 2014 or any subsequent Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday or Friday night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

(ii) 13 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Saturday 8th February 2014 or any subsequent Saturday night thereafter until the said works have been completed; or

(iii) 14 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Sunday 9th February 2014 or any subsequent Sunday night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the second works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5 no person shall, during the first works period, cause or permit any vehicle with an overall width exceeding 3 metres to enter or proceed in the slip road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs. Nothing shall apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
