**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A1 Trunk Road (Stretton, Lincolnshire) (Temporary  
Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

<i>Made</i> - - - -	<i>27th May 2014</i>
<i>Coming into force</i> - -	<i>3rd June 2014</i>

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road (“the A1”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that trunk road and one of those connecting roads at Stretton in the County of Lincolnshire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Stretton, Lincolnshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Tuesday 3rd June 2014.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A1 from a point 1950 metres south of its junction with the slip road leading to the B668 Greetham Road (at Stretton), to a point approximately 250 metres north of that junction;

“the slip road” means the slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the A1 to its junction with the B668 Greetham Road (at Stretton);

"the works period" means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 9th June 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the slip road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of –

a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes;

b) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle -

(i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or

(ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and

c) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
