ROAD TRAFFIC

The A46 Trunk Road (Bishopton, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 27th May 2014

Coming into force - - 3rd June 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”) is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, at Bishopton, in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) , hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Bishopton, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Tuesday 3rd June 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the works period” means the period starting at 18:00 hours on Monday 9th June 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to leave the circulatory carriageway of the A46 and Birmingham Road (Bishopton Roundabout) at its junction with Bishopton Lane.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-
- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
 - (c) being used in connection with the said works; or
 - (d) proceeding to and from premises which are accessible from, and only from, Bishopton Lane.
