ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M3 Motorway (Junction 6, Spur Road) (Temporary
Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - - *9th June 2014*

Coming into force - - - - - *28th June 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M3 Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that motorway and on those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M3 Motorway (Junction 6, Spur Road) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 28th June 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M3 Motorway in the County of Hampshire;

“the length of carriageway” means both carriageways of the M3 spur road between Junction 6 and Black Dam roundabout (A30);

“works” mean construction of new carriageway, widening of existing carriageway and all associated work; and

“a works period” means a period of 24 hours starting at 0001 hours on Tuesday 1st July 2014 or on any subsequent day until 27th December 2015.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. Nothing in article 4 shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes and to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(b) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
