ROAD TRAFFIC

The A27 Trunk Road (Fontwell Roundabout, Westbound Lay-by) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - - *27th January 2014*

Coming into force - - - - - *15th February 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A27 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A27 Trunk Road (Fontwell Roundabout, Westbound Lay-by) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 15th February 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A27 Trunk Road (Arundel Road) in the County of West Sussex;

“lay-by” means an area of carriageway, intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b);

“the A27 lay-by” means a lay-by in the westbound carriageway of the trunk road between points 106 metres west and 236 metres west of Fontwell roundabout (A29);

“works” mean cable replacement and street lighting work on the trunk road; and

“the works period” means the period starting on Monday 17th February 2014 or on any subsequent day and ending on 14th August 2015.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in, or wait on, the A27 lay-by.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or

(d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
