### ROAD TRAFFIC

# The A40 Trunk Road (Highnam Right Turn Bans, Gloucestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - 25th June 2014

Coming into force - - 28th June 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A40 Trunk Road ("the A40"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Highnam in the County of Gloucestershire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A40 Trunk Road (Highnam Right Turn Bans, Gloucestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 28th June 2014.

#### 2. In this Order –

"the A40" means the westbound carriageway of the A40 near Highnam between the A417 Roundabout and the A48 Roundabout;

"central reservation" means that part of the trunk road which separates its carriageways for the safety and guidance of vehicular traffic using that road;

"the works" mean the replacement of road lining;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Tuesday 1st July 2014 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed through the gaps in the central reservation of the A40 opposite the junctions with Horseshoe Drive, Over Farm Market and the B4215 towards Highnam and Newent.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
  - (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
