ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A627(M) Motorway (Northbound Carriageway between the
M62 Junction 20 Roundabout and the A664 Edinburgh Way)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - *20th June 2014*
Coming into force - - *6th July 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A627(M) Motorway, is satisfied that traffic on a section of that motorway in the District of Rochdale in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A627(M) Motorway (Northbound Carriageway between the M62 Junction 20 Roundabout and the A664 Edinburgh Way) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 6th July 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the A627(M);

“works” means traffic signal replacement and maintenance works;

“the works period” means a period overnight between 2200 hours and 0500 hours starting on Monday 7 July 2014 and ending on Tuesday 8 July 2014. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“the length of carriageway” means the northbound carriageway of the motorway from the point where it leaves the circulatory carriageway of the M62 Junction 20 roundabout to its end point at the junction with the A664 Edinburgh Way.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
