**The A1(M) Motorway (Junction 7 Stevenage, Hertfordshire)
Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - - *23rd June 2014*

Coming into force - - - - - *30th June 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1(M) Motorway (“the A1(M)”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads at Stevenage in the County of Hertfordshire should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public due to a large scale musical festival nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway (Junction 7 Stevenage, Hertfordshire) Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 30th June 2014.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during the period starting at 05:00 hours on Thursday 3rd July 2014 and ending at 15:00 hours on Monday 7th July 2014 when the likelihood of danger to the public has ceased, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the northbound entry or southbound exit slip roads of the A1(M) at Junction 7.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes, or proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
