### ROAD TRAFFIC

# The A38 Trunk Road (Carkeel Roundabout to Saltash Tunnel) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 26th June 2014

Coming into force - - 2nd July 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road ("the A38"), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road at Saltash in Cornwall should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Carkeel Roundabout to Saltash Tunnel) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 2nd July 2014.

#### 2. In this Order –

"the A38" means (i) the A38 eastbound at Saltash between the eastern edge of Carkeel Roundabout and its junction with the B3271 at the Tamar Bridge Junction; and (ii) the A38 westbound at Saltash between the tip of the nosing of the westbound exit slip road at the Saltash Town Junction and the eastern edge of Carkeel Roundabout;

"the tip of the nosing" means the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a trunk road;

"the works" mean electrical testing, sign replacement, carriageway and tunnel maintenance works;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Friday 4th July 2014 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3**. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A38.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
  - (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(b) anything	done	at the	direction	of, o	r with	the	permission	of,	a constable	or traffic	officer	in

(c) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works.
