**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M62 Motorway (Tour de France) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

*Made* - - - - - *26th June 2014*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *5th July 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M62 Motorway, in the Districts of Kirklees and Calderdale, in the County of West Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads should be prohibited for the purpose of facilitating the holding of a relevant event:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16A (2)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M62 Motorway (Tour de France) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 5th July 2014.

**2.** In this Order:-

“the M62” means the M62 Motorway;

“the slip road” means the M62 eastbound and westbound entry and exit slip roads at Junction 24 (Ainley Top)

“event” means the Tour de France cycling event;

“the event period” means a period between 04:00 hours and 18:00 hours on Sunday 6th July 2014, continuing as necessary to facilitate the holding of the event.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the event period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, any vehicle being used in connection with the cycling event, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform or an official event marshal or steward.
