ROAD TRAFFIC

The A3 Trunk Road (Burpham Interchange – Hog’s Back Link Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 30th June 2014

Coming into force - - 19th July 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A3 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on lengths of that trunk road and on some of those connecting road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A3 Trunk Road (Burpham Interchange – Hog’s Back Link Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 19th July 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A3 Trunk Road in the County of Surrey;

“the length of carriageway” means the southbound carriageway of the trunk road between the tip of the nosing of the ‘off’ slip road at Burpham Interchange (A3100) and the tip of the nosing of the link road leading to A31 (Hog’s Back);

“a slip road means –

- (i) the road leading from the southbound carriageway of the trunk road at Stoke Interchange (A320),
- (ii) the road leading to the southbound carriageway of the trunk road at Dennis Interchange (A322/A25),
- (iii) the road leading to the southbound carriageway of the trunk road at University Interchange, or
- (iv) the road leading from the southbound carriageway of the trunk road at University Interchange;

“works” mean carriageway repairs and all associated work including, but not limited to resurfacing, remarking, bridge inspections, drainage improvements, vegetation clearance and reinstatement of studs;

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday – Friday and 12 hours starting at 2100 hours on Saturday 26th July 2014 or on any subsequent Saturday until 18th January 2016.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
