**The M25 Motorway and The M11 Motorway (M25 Junction 26
and M11 Junction 5) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order
2014**

<i>Made</i> - - - -	<i>9th June 2014</i>
<i>Coming into force</i> - -	<i>6th July 2014</i>

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M25 and M11 Motorways and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on some of those connecting roads for the purpose of facilitating the holding of a relevant event:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M25 Motorway and The M11 Motorway (M25 Junction 26 and M11 Junction 5) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 6th July 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the first motorway” means the M25 Motorway in the County of Essex,

“the second motorway” means the M11 Motorway in the County of Essex;

“a slip road” means –

- (i) the road leading from the clockwise carriageway of the first motorway at junction 26, or
- (ii) the road leading from the northbound carriageway of the second motorway at junction 5;

“event” means the Tour de France Cycle Road Races; and

“an event period” means a period of 3 days starting at 0001 hours on Sunday 6th July 2014.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during an event period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to –

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said event;

- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;

- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (d) a vehicle being used for the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency; or
- (e) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
