**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M27 Motorway (Junctions 1 – 12, Carriageways)  
(Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014**

*Made* - - - - *7th July 2014*

*Coming into force* - - *26th July 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M27 Motorway, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on lengths of that motorway because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M27 Motorway (Junctions 1 - 12, Carriageways) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 26th July 2014 and shall apply for a period of twelve months.

**2.** In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M27 Motorway in the County of Hampshire, the City of Southampton and the City of Portsmouth;

“the Regulations” means the regulation 16(2) of the Motorways Traffic (England and Wales) Regulations 1982(b);

“the length of motorway” means both carriageways of the motorway between Junction 1 (A31) at Cadnam Interchange and Junction 12 (A3/A27/A397) at Hilsea Interchange;

“a hard shoulder” means the hard shoulder, within the meaning of regulation 3(1)(e) of the Regulations, which is adjacent to the length of motorway;

“works” mean essential carriageway repairs and all associated work on the motorway; and

“a works period” means a period of –

- (i) 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 28th July 2014 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday,
- (ii) 6½ hours starting at 2300 hours on Friday 1st August 2014 or on any subsequent Friday or Sunday, or
- (iii) 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 2nd August 2014 or on any subsequent Saturday,

until Saturday 25th July 2015.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of motorway or a hard shoulder.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes and to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

5. During a works period, the provisions of regulations 5 and (insofar as it relates to a vehicle being driven) 9 of the Regulations are hereby suspended, in respect of a hard shoulder, at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
