**The Control of Noise (Code of Practice on Noise from Audible Intruder Alarms) (Revocation) (England) Order 2014**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 71(3) of the Control of Pollution Act 1974<sup>(1)</sup>, makes the following Order.

**Citation, application and commencement**

1. This Order—
  - (a) may be cited as the Control of Noise (Code of Practice on Noise from Audible Intruder Alarms) (Revocation) (England) Order 2014;
  - (b) applies in England; and
  - (c) comes into force on 1st October 2014.

**Revocation**

2. The Control of Noise (Code of Practice on Noise from Audible Intruder Alarms) Order 1981<sup>(2)</sup> is revoked.
