**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M32 Motorway (Junction 1) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

*Made* - - - - *28th July 2014*

*Coming into force* - - *9th August 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M32 Motorway (“the M32”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in South Gloucestershire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the M32 Motorway (Junction 1) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 9th August 2014.

2. In this Order –

- “the M32” means the southbound carriageway of the M32 at Junction 1;
- “the slip road” means the southbound entry slip road at M32 Junction 1;
- “the tip of the nosing” means the first point where an entry slip road joins the carriageway of a motorway or the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a motorway;
- “the works” mean the installation of duct crossing and re-surfacing works.
- “a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 11th August 2014 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to an article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works or for winter maintenance purposes.
