ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A1(M) Motorway (Junction 45 to Junction 42)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - *31st July 2014*

Coming into force - *11th August 2014*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1(M) Motorway and connecting roads, in the District of Leeds, in the County of West Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that motorway and some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because carriageway resurfacing, road sweeping, loop cutting, gully emptying, white lining, road studding and general maintenance works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway (Junction 45 to Junction 42) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 11th August 2014.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Tuesday 12th August 2014 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the:

- (i) A1(M) Motorway southbound carriageway from the nose of the exit slip road at Junction 45 (Boston Spa) to the nose of the entry slip road at Junction 42 (Selby Fork), a distance of 19242 metres;
- (ii) A1(M) Motorway southbound entry slip road at Junction 44 (Bramham Crossroads); or
- (ii) link road connecting the A64 Trunk Road westbound carriageway to the A1(M) Motorway southbound carriageway at Junction 44.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
