ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A590 Trunk Road (Levens to Lindale) (Temporary
Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - *29th January 2014*

Coming into force - - *16th February 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport being the traffic authority for the A590 Trunk Road is satisfied that traffic on sections of that trunk road in the District of South Lakeland in the County of Cumbria, should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A590 Trunk Road (Levens to Lindale) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 16th February 2014.
2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A590 Trunk Road.

“the first length of carriageway” means the eastbound dual carriageway section of the trunk road from the kerbed nosing of the western end of the dual carriageway to the centreline of Lawrence House accommodation overbridge.

“the second length of carriageway” means the westbound dual carriageway section of the trunk road from the centreline of Lawrence House accommodation overbridge to the kerbed nosing of the western end of the dual carriageway.

“the third length of carriageway” means the single carriageway section of the trunk road from the centreline of the Beck Head junction to the kerbed nosing of the western end of the dual carriageway.

“the works period” means a period starting at 0001 hours on Monday 17 February 2014 and ending at 2359 hours on Friday 14 March 2014. However, works may start and continue beyond these dates for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work.

“works” means drainage renewal works on the trunk road.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in the first, second and third lengths of carriageway at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance services or anything done at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.

5. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 (a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
