ROAD TRAFFIC

The M62 Motorway (Junction 38 to Junction 37) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - *14th August 2014*

Coming into force - - *25th August 2014*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M62 Motorway and connecting roads, in the East Riding of Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that motorway and some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because carriageway resurfacing, carriageway repairs, road markings and stud replacement works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the M62 Motorway (Junction 38 to Junction 37) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 25th August 2014.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Tuesday 26th August 2014 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the M62 Motorway:

- (i) eastbound carriageway from the nose of the eastbound exit slip road at Junction 37 (Howden) to the nose of the eastbound entry slip road at Junction 38 (North Cave), a distance of 14200 metres;
- (ii) westbound carriageway from the nose of the westbound exit slip road at Junction 38 to the nose of the westbound entry slip road at Junction 37, a distance of 14350 metres;
- (iii) eastbound entry and westbound exit slip road at Junction 37; or
- (iv) eastbound exit and westbound entry slip road at Junction 38.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
