ROAD TRAFFIC

The M62 Motorway (Junction 34 to Junction 36) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - *28th August 2014*

Coming into force - - *9th September 2014*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M62 Motorway and connecting roads, in the Counties of North Yorkshires and the East Riding of Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that motorway and some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because carriageway road marking, road stud renewal and general maintenance works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M62 Motorway (Junction 34 to Junction 36) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 9th September 2014.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Wednesday 10th September 2014 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the:

- (i) M62 Motorway eastbound and westbound carriageways from a point 390 metres west of the centre point of All Saints Interchange west overbridge at Junction 34 (Whitley) to a point 300 metres east of the centre point of Goole Interchange overbridge at Junction 36 (Airmyrn), a distance of 15400 metres;
- (ii) M62 eastbound entry and westbound exit slip roads at Junction 34;
- (iii) M62 eastbound exit and westbound entry slip roads at Junction 36;
- (iv) link road connecting the M18 Motorway northbound carriageway to the M62 Motorway westbound carriageway at Langham Interchange (the M18 Motorway Junction 7 and the M62 Motorway Junction 35)
- (v) link road connecting the M18 Motorway northbound carriageway to the M62 Motorway eastbound carriageway at Langham Interchange;
- (vi) link road connecting the M62 Motorway westbound carriageway to the M18 Motorway southbound carriageway at Langham Interchange; or
- (vii) link road connecting the M62 Motorway eastbound carriageway to the M18 Motorway southbound carriageway at Langham Interchange.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
