



means a way constituting or comprised in a trunk road (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“works” mean resurfacing, renewal of road marking and road studs, gully cleaning and landscape maintenance;

“a works period” means a period of 7 hours starting at 22.00 hours on Monday 15th September 2014 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

“the works period” means the period starting at 12.00 hours on Monday 15th September 2014 and ending when the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or –

(a) proceed in the trunk road or a slip road, during a works period, or

(b) wait in any lay-by adjacent to the trunk road during the works period.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle –

(a) being used in connection with the works,

(b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes, or

(c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
