ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A259 Trunk Road (Lamb Inn – Hooe Junction) (Temporary
Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - *25th August 2014*

Coming into force - - *13th September 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A259 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that road and prohibited on one of the lay-bys because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A259 Trunk Road (Lamb Inn – Hooe Junction) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 13th September 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A259 Trunk Road in the County of East Sussex;

“the first length of trunk road” means both carriageways of the trunk road between points 1430 metres south and 1963 metres east of Sewer Bridge Hooe underbridge;

“the second length of trunk road” means both carriageways of the trunk road between points 450 metres south and 1040 metres east of Sewer Bridge Hooe underbridge;

“works” mean resurfacing, road marking, reinstallation of studs and all associated carriageway work on the trunk road;

“a first works period” means a period of 24 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 15th September 2014 or on any subsequent day until 12th March 2016; and

“a second works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 15th September 2014 or on any subsequent day until 12th March 2016.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 below, no person shall, –

- (a) during a first works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road when that speed is indicated by a traffic sign; or
- (b) during a first works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the second length of trunk road when that speed is indicated by a traffic sign; or
- (c) during a second works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the second length of trunk road while traffic signs of a character authorised under

section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that road are displayed.

4. The provisions of articles 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. (1) Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.

(2) Nothing in article 4 above shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes and to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
