**The A14 Trunk Road (Junction 51 Beacon Hill, Needham
Market, Suffolk) Westbound (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic)
Order 2014**

Made - - - - *15th September 2014*

Coming into force - - *22nd September 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A14 Trunk Road (“the A14”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Suffolk should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A14 Trunk Road (Junction 51 Beacon Hill, Needham Market, Suffolk) Westbound (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 22nd September 2014.

2. In this Order –

“tip of the nosing” means, as indicated by the markings on the carriageway, the first point where an entry slip road joins, or the last point where an exit slip road leaves, the carriageway of the trunk road;

“the trunk road” means the A14 westbound carriageway from the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road to the A14/A140 Junction 51 Beacon Hill Interchange to the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road from Coddanham Road/Kettle Lane, Needham Market;

“works” mean installation of a Weigh-In-Motion system on behalf of the Driver and Vehicle Standards Agency;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 29th September 2014 or on any subsequent day (other than a Saturday or a Sunday), until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle –

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (a) being used in connection with the works,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes, or
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
