ROAD TRAFFIC

The M25 Motorway (Junction 15) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - - *8th September 2014*

Coming into force - - - - - *28th September 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M25 Motorway and connecting roads in the county of Buckinghamshire, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted and prohibited on lengths of the motorway because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M25 Motorway (Junction 15) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 28th September 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the M25” means the M25 Motorway in the County of Buckinghamshire;

“the first length of carriageway” means the clockwise carriageway of the M25 between the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road and the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road at Junction 15;

“the second length of carriageway” means the anticlockwise carriageway of the M25 between the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road and the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road at Junction 15;

“works” mean bridge joint replacement and all associated work; and

“a works period” means a period of –

- (i) 7½ hours starting at 22:00 hours on Tuesday 30th September 2014 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday,
- (ii) 7 hours starting at 2300 hours on Friday 3rd October 2014 or on any subsequent Friday,
- (iii) 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 4th October 2014 or on any subsequent Saturday, or
- (iv) 7 hours starting at 2230 hours on Sunday 5th October 2014 or on any subsequent Sunday,

until 27th March 2016.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 below, no person shall, during a works period cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a length of carriageway,

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to –

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
