The Bolsover (Electoral Changes) Order 2014

Made - - - - *14th July 2014*

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

Under section 92(2) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007^(a) (“the Act”) Bolsover District Council made recommendations to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England^(b) for the related alteration of the boundaries of district wards within the Council’s area.

The Local Government Boundary Commission for England has decided to give effect to the recommendations and, in exercise of the power conferred by section 92(3) of the Act, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Bolsover (Electoral Changes) Order 2014.
- (2) This Order comes into force—
 - (a) for the purpose of proceedings preliminary or relating to the election of councillors, on 15th October 2014;
 - (b) for all other purposes, on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—
 - “the 2013 Order” means the Bolsover District Council Whitwell and Elmton-with-Cresswell Parishes (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2013^(c);
 - “district ward” means a ward established by article 2 of the District of Bolsover (Electoral Changes) Order 1999^(d);
 - “ordinary day of election of councillors” has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983^(e).

The functions of the Electoral Commission under Chapter 3 of Part 4 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 (c.28) (“the 2007 Act”) were transferred to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England with effect from 1st April 2010 by section 60 of the 2009 Act.

Related alterations of district ward boundaries

3. Each area that ceases to be part of the parish of Whitwell and becomes part of the parish of Elmton-with-Cresswell in consequence of the 2013 Order ceases to be part of Whitwell district ward and becomes part of Elmton-with-Cresswell district ward.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Bolsover District Council to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for related alterations of district ward boundaries. These alterations are related to parish boundary changes made by the Bolsover District Council Whitwell and Elmton with Cresswell Parishes (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2013.

The new boundaries apply in respect of district elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

Article 3 alters the district wards of Whitwell and Elmton-with-Cresswell.

An impact assessment has not been produced for this instrument as no impact on the private or voluntary sectors is foreseen.
