**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A1(M) Motorway (Junction 59) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.4) Order 2014**

*Made* - - - - *18th September 2014*

*Coming into force* - - *28th September 2014*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1(M) Motorway and the A167 Trunk Road, in the County of Durham, is satisfied that traffic on that motorway and that trunk road should be prohibited because carriageway resurfacing works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway (Junction 59) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.4) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 28th September 2014.

**2.** In this Order:

“the A1(M)” means the A1(M) Motorway;

“the A167” means the A167 Trunk Road;

“a slip road” means the A1(M) northbound and southbound entry and exit slip roads at Junction 59 (Coatham Mundeville);

“the roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of the A167 at Coatham Mundeville Interchange;

“the works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 29th September 2014 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road or the roundabout.

**4.** The provisions of articles 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or

(c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

and nothing in article 3 shall apply to any vehicle proceeding in the A1(M) or A167 to or from premises and property which is accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
