

- (i) 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 13th October 2014 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday,
- (ii) 7 hours starting at 2300 hours on Friday 17th October 2014 or on any subsequent Friday,
- (iii) 8 hours starting at 2200 hours Saturday 18th October 2014 or on any subsequent Saturday, or
- (iv) 7 hours starting at 2230 hours on Sunday 19th October 2014 or on any subsequent Sunday;

until 10th April 2016.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road, the link road, the first length of carriageway or the second length of carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to –

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
