**The M50 Motorway (M5 Junction 8 - M50 Junction 1)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - *3rd October 2014*

Coming into force - - *10th October 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M50 Motorway (“the M50”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway, in the Counties of Worcestershire and Gloucestershire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M50 Motorway (M5 Junction 8 - M50 Junction 1) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Friday 10th October 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the westbound carriageway of the M50 from the roundabout junction with the M5 (M5 Junction 8), to the junction with the entry slip road at M50 Junction 1;

“the works period” means the period starting at 22:00 hours on Monday 13th October 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the motorway.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- c) being used in connection with the said works, or by, or with permission of, a traffic officer in uniform.
