ROAD TRAFFIC

The A500 Trunk Road (Etruria, Stoke-on-Trent) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - *3rd October 2014*
Coming into force - - *10th October 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A500 Trunk Road (“the A500”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and one of those connecting roads, at Etruria in the City of Stoke-on-Trent, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A500 Trunk Road (Etruria, Stoke-on-Trent) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Friday 10th October 2014.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the southbound carriageway of the A500 from the junction with the slip road leading to the roundabout junction with the A53 Etruria Road, to the slip road leading from the junction with the B5045 Shelton New Road;

“the slip road” means the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A500 from the roundabout junction with the A53 Etruria Road;

"the works period" means the period starting at 21:00 hours on Friday 17th October 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- c) being used in connection with the said works.
