**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A38 Trunk Road (Egginton to Branston, Staffordshire)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

*Made - - - - 3rd February 2014*

*Coming into force - - 10th February 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”) is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, between Egginton and Branston, in the County of Staffordshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) , hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Egginton to Branston, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 10th February 2014.

2. In this Order:

| “Branston Junction” | the circulatory carriageway of the A5121 Wellington Road and Branston Road at Branston;   |
| “the trunk road”    | means the southbound carriageway of the A38 from its junction with the unnamed road leading to the A5132 (The Castle Way) to its junction with the slip road leading from Branston Junction |
| “the works period”  | means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 17th February 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;   |

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
