**The M57 Motorway (Junction 1 Southbound Carriageway to the
A5300 Knowsley Expressway) (Temporary Prohibition of
Traffic) Order 2014**

<i>Made</i> - - - - -	<i>8th October 2014</i>
<i>Coming into force</i> - -	<i>23rd October 2014</i>

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M57 Motorway, is satisfied that traffic on a section of that motorway in the District of Knowsley in Merseyside should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M57 Motorway (Junction 1 Southbound Carriageway to the A5300 Knowsley Expressway) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 23rd October 2014.
2. In this Order:
 - “the motorway” means the M57 Motorway at Junction 1;
 - “works” means improvement works to the A5300 Knowsley Expressway by Knowsley Council;
 - “the length of carriageway” means the southbound carriageway of the motorway from the last point where the exit slip road leading to the circulatory carriageway of the M62 Junction 6 (Tarbock Island) roundabout leaves the carriageway, to the point where it merges with the A5300 Knowsley Expressway;
 - “the works period” means a period starting at 2200 hours on Friday 24 October 2014 and ending at 0600 hours on Monday 27 October 2014. However, work may start and continue beyond these dates for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work.
3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
