**The A52 Trunk Road (Edwalton - Gamston, Nottinghamshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - 13th October 2014

Coming into force - - 20th October 2014

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A52 Trunk Road (“the A52”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, between Edwalton and Gamston in the County of Nottinghamshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A52 Trunk Road (Edwalton - Gamston, Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 20th October 2014.

2. In this Order –

| “Wheatcroft Island” | means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A52 and the A606 Melton Road; |
| “Gamston Roundabout” | means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A52 and the A6011 Radcliffe Road; |
| “the trunk road” | means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A52 between Wheatcroft Island and Gamston Roundabout; |
| “central reservation” | means that part of the trunk road which separates its carriageways for the safety and guidance of vehicular traffic using that road; |
| “layby” | means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b) and partly by the |

outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

“the works period”

means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 27th October 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 8 and 9, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 8 and 9, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed through the gaps in the central reservation opposite –

- a) Tollerton Lane; and
- b) Ambleside.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 8 and 9, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in any layby situated adjacent to the trunk road.

6. Subject as mentioned in articles 8 and 9, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the trunk road at the junction with –

- a) Tollerton Lane; and
- b) Ambleside.

7. Subject as mentioned in articles 8 and 9, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any pedestrian to enter or leave the trunk road at the junction with the undesignated access path 70 metres north of ‘The Goose Inn’.

8. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

9. The provisions of –

- (a) articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
 - (iii) being used in connection with the said works; and
- (b) article 7 shall not apply to any person –
 - (i) engaged in police, fire brigade or ambulance activity; or
 - (ii) engaged in activity connected with the works.
