ROAD TRAFFIC

The A49 Trunk Road (Holmer Road, Hereford) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2014

Made---9th October 2014Coming into force--23rd October 2014

The Secretary of State for Transport makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2) and 4(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$:

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A49 Trunk Road (Holmer Road, Hereford) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 23rd October 2014.
 - 2. In this Order -

"the trunk road"

means the westside of the A49, known as Holmer Road, in the City of Hereford, between points 69 metres south and 27.5 metres north of the centre point of its junction with Herbie Samuels Way (access road to Hereford Leisure Centre).

- **3**. Subject to article 4, no person shall, except upon the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable or traffic warden in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the trunk road at any time on any day.
 - **4.** Article 3 will not apply—
 - (a) so as to prevent a vehicle waiting on the trunk road for so long as may be necessary for it to be used in connection with
 - (i) any building operation or demolition,
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic,
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the trunk road, or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal in or near the trunk road of any sewer, main, pipe, conduit, wire, cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity, or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984(b); or
 - (b) in relation to a vehicle being used—
 - (i) for fire and rescue authority, ambulance or police purposes,
 - (ii) in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties, or

- (iii) in the service of a water undertaker or sewerage undertaker within the meaning of the Water Industry Act 1991(a).
- **5.** The prohibitions, restrictions and requirements imposed by this Order are in addition to and not in derogation of any prohibition, restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment, and any exception to, or exemption from the provisions of this Order is without prejudice to the provisions of any other enactment.
