

“a works period” means a period of 9 hours starting at 21.00 hours on Monday 3rd November 2014 or on any subsequent day (other than a Saturday or Sunday) until the works have been completed;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Monday 3rd November 2014 and ending when the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or –

- (a) proceed in the trunk road or a slip road, during a works period, or
- (b) wait in any lay-by adjacent to the trunk road, during the works period.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs.

5. Nothing in article 3 shall apply to a vehicle –

- (a) being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or traffic officer in uniform.
