ROAD TRAFFIC

The A406 Trunk Road (M11 Junction 4) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - *13th October 2014*

Coming into force - - *3rd November 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A406 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on some of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A406 Trunk Road (M11 Junction 4) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 3rd November 2014.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A406 Trunk road in Greater London and in the County of Essex;

“the link road” means the road leading from the northbound carriageway of the A406 (North Circular Road) to the northbound carriageway of the M11 at Junction 4;

“works” means drainage maintenance;

“a works period” means a period of –

- (i) 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Wednesday 5th November 2014 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday,
- (ii) 7 hours starting at 2300 hours on Friday 7th November 2014 or on any subsequent Friday,
- (iii) 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 8th November 2014 or on any subsequent Saturday, or
- (iv) 7 hours starting at 2230 hours on Sunday 9th November 2014 or on any subsequent Sunday,

until 2nd May 2016.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the link road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
