**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 40, Southbound Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

*Made* - - - - - *5th November 2014*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *9th November 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A55 Trunk Road and its slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those slip roads in Cheshire West and Chester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A55 Trunk Road (Junction 40, Southbound Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 9th November 2014.

**2.** In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A55 Trunk Road;

“work” means drainage and general maintenance works;

“the works period” means periods overnight between 2000 hours and 0500 hours (continuing to 0700 hours on Saturday and Sunday mornings) during a period starting on Monday 10th November 2014 and ending on Friday 30th January 2015. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“the slip road” means the entry slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the trunk road at Junction 40.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.
4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works or being used for winter maintenance purposes, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
