**The A5 Trunk Road (Old Stratford - Bradwell Abbey,
Northamptonshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order
2014**

Made - - - - *17th November 2014*
Coming into force - - *24th November 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, between Old Stratford and Bradwell Abbey at Milton Keynes in the County of Northamptonshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Old Stratford - Bradwell Abbey, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Monday 24th November 2014.

2. In this Order –

“Old Stratford Roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A5, A508, Towcester Road and the A422;

“Abbey Hill Roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A5, Great Monks Street and Monks Way;

“the trunk road” means –
a) Old Stratford Roundabout;
b) the northbound carriageway of the A5 from the slip road leading to Abbey Hill Roundabout, to Old Stratford Roundabout; and
c) the southbound carriageway of the A5 from Old Stratford Roundabout, to the slip road leading from Abbey Hill Roundabout;

“the slip road”	means the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A5 from Abbey Hill Roundabout;
“layby”	means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(a) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;
"the works period"	means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Sunday 30th November 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or the slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the laybys situated adjacent to the northbound carriageway of the A5 approximately –

- a) 3200 metres north of the centrepoint of Abbey Hill Roundabout; and
- b) 4700 metres north of the centrepoint of Abbey Hill Roundabout.

5. Subject as mentioned in article 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave Old Stratford Roundabout at the junction with the A508.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- c) being used in connection with the said works.
