**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A5 Trunk Road (Higham-On-The-Hill) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

*Made* - - - - *19th December 2014*

*Coming into force* - - *27th December 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, southeast of Atherstone in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Higham-On-The-Hill) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Saturday 27th December 2014.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3, during the period starting at 00:01 hours on Saturday 27th December 2014 and ending when the said likelihood of danger has been avoided by means other than this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to turn right from –

- a) the northbound carriageway of the A5 into Wood Lane; or
- b) Wood Lane into the northbound carriageway of the A5.

3. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
