ROAD TRAFFIC

The A47 Trunk Road and the A1 Trunk Road (Wansford to Sutton, City of Peterborough) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014

Made - - - - 29th December 2014

Coming into force - - 5th January 2015

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A47 Trunk Road (“the A47”) and the A1 Trunk Road (“the A1”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of those roads and on some of those connecting roads, in the City of Peterborough, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A47 Trunk Road and the A1 Trunk Road (Wansford to Sutton, City of Peterborough) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 5th January 2015.

2. In this Order –

“Sutton Roundabout” means the A47/Nene Way roundabout, Sutton;

“the trunk road” means the A47 between its junctions with the west roundabout at Wansford Interchange and Sutton Roundabout;

“a slip road” means the –

(a) exit slip road from the southbound carriageway of the A1 leading to the A47 east roundabout at Wansford Interchange, and

(b) entry slip road to the southbound carriageway of the A1 from the A47 east roundabout at Wansford Interchange;

“works” mean carriageway widening and resurfacing, traffic signal installation, renewal of traffic loops, road markings and studs, traffic sign replacement, kerbing and associated routine maintenance to include gully cleaning and landscape maintenance;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 12th January 2015 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (a) being used for, or in connection with, the works, winter maintenance or for traffic officer purposes,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes,
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform, or
- (d) requiring access to or from properties which are accessible from, and only from, the trunk road.
