ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A40 Trunk Road (Churcham, Gloucestershire) (Temporary
Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - *7th January 2014*

Coming into force - - *11th January 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A40 Trunk Road (“the A40”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Churcham in the District of Forest of Dean in the County of Gloucestershire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A40 Trunk Road (Churcham, Gloucestershire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 11th January 2014.

2. In this Order –

“the A40” means the A40 at Churcham from a point at the eastern edge of the A48 Highnam Roundabout to a point 250 metres west of its junction with Sainthill Road (leading to Sainthill Farm);

“the works” mean resurfacing, road markings, road studs and node markings;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 13th January 2014 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to an article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the A40.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the A40 whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that road are displayed.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes; or

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

(b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.

6. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
