

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 no pedestrian shall, during a works period, enter or proceed in the footway adjacent to the northbound carriageway of the A1 between points 20 metres south and 100 metres north of the right turn lane (exit slip road) to New Road, Beeston, Sandy.

5. The provisions of article 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs.

6. Nothing in article 4 shall apply to –

- (a) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the works, winter maintenance or for traffic officer purposes,
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes,
- (c) anything being done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform or
- (d) any pedestrian being escorted past the works or requiring access to or from premises that are accessible from, and only from, those footways.

and nothing in article 3 shall apply to a vehicle being used for a purpose specified in paragraph (b) of this article or a vehicle falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
