ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A19 Trunk Road (Elwick South Junction) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic)
Order 2014**

Made - - - - - *20th February 2014*

Coming into force - *28th February 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A19 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the District of Hartlepool, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road and one of those connecting roads should be prohibited because local authority works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A19 Trunk Road (Elwick South Junction) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 28th February 2014.

2. In this Order: -

“the A19” means the A19 Trunk Road;

“the central reservation” means that part of the A19 which separates its carriageways for the safety and guidance of traffic using that road;

“the works period” means a period starting at 09:30 hours on Saturday 1 March 2014 and ending when the said works have been completed.

“the slip road” means the A19 southbound exit slip road at Church Lane, Elwick South Junction.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5 of this Order, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5 of this Order, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed through a gap in the centre reservation at Elwick South Junction.

5. The provisions article 3 and 4 of this Order apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs. Nothing in article 3 and 4 shall apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
