ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1 Trunk Road (Southoe to Buckden, Cambridgeshire) (60 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2014

Made - - - - *7th March 2014*
Coming into force - - *21st March 2014*

The Secretary of State for Transport makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a):

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Southoe to Buckden, Cambridgeshire) (60 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 21st March 2014.

2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 60 miles per hour on a length of the A1 Trunk Road in the District of Huntingdonshire in the County of Cambridgeshire between points 53 metres south and 3,473 metres south of the centre line of its junction with Stirtloe Lane, Buckden, a distance of 3,420 metres.

This Order will impose a permanent speed limit of 60 miles per hour on the A1.
