**The A11 Trunk Road (Fulbourn, Cambridgeshire) Exit Slip
Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - *3rd March 2014*
Coming into force - - *10th March 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A11 Trunk Road (“the A11”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads in the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A11 Trunk Road (Fulbourn, Cambridgeshire) Exit Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on 10th March 2014.
2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 17th March 2014 or on any subsequent day until installation of traffic signs, verge maintenance, barrier maintenance and drainage works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the exit slip road from the northbound carriageway or the exit slip road from the southbound carriageway of the A11 at Fulbourn.
3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used in connection with the works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance, traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes.
