**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Strathallan Castle)
Regulations 2015**

Made - - - - - *15th April 2015*

Coming into force - - - *9th July 2015*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Strathallan Castle, Perth and Kinross, by reason of the intended gathering of a large number of persons at the T in the Park 2015 Music Festival which is scheduled to take place in the period from 9th to 13th July 2015.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Strathallan Castle) Regulations 2015 and come into force on 9th July 2015.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3(1) all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time(b).

Restricted airspace

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), between 0500 hours on 9th July and 1400 hours on 13th July 2015, no aircraft is to fly below 3,500 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by a circle having a radius of 1.5 nautical miles whose centre is at 561912N 0034434W.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying in accordance with a permission issued by Inspector Jenny Valentine or Sergeant Alan Wilson of Police Service of Scotland.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Strathallan Castle, Perth and Kinross, by reason of the T in the Park 2015 Music Festival that is scheduled to take place there from 9th to 13th July 2015. A large gathering of people will attend this event on each day and therefore the Civil Aviation Authority's Safety and Airspace Regulation Group considers that flying should be restricted in the vicinity of the displays for reasons of public safety and security grounds and this has been agreed with the Department for Transport.

The times mentioned in regulation 3(1) are Universal Co-ordinated Time (UTC), which for the purpose of these Regulations is one hour behind British Summer Time.

Full details of the Statutory Instrument will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
