ROAD TRAFFIC

The A66 Trunk Road (Little Burdon Roundabout to Yarm Road Interchange) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2015

Made - - - - - *19th February 2015*

Coming into force - - - - - *1st March 2015*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A66 Trunk Road, in the Districts of Darlington and Teesside, in the County of Durham, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be restricted because works to replace worn lanterns in the central reserve are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A66 Trunk Road (Little Burdon Roundabout to Yarm Road Interchange) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2015 and shall come into force on 1st March 2015.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 2nd March 2015 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the A66 Trunk Road:

- (i) eastbound carriageway from its junction with Little Burdon Roundabout eastwards for a distance of 10700 metres; or
- (ii) westbound carriageway from its junction with Yarm Road Interchange westwards for a distance of 10700 metres.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.

4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(b) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
