ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M5 Motorway (Junction 18 ‘Y’ Loop Slip Road)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015**

Made - - - - *6th March 2015*

Coming into force - - *14th March 2015*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M5 Motorway (“the M5”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads at Junction 18 in the City of Bristol should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the M5 Motorway (Junction 18 ‘Y’ Loop Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2015 and shall come into force on 14th March 2015.

2. In this Order –

“the slip road” means the south bound entry slip road at M5 junction 18 leading from St. Brendans roundabout to the tip of the nosing with the southbound carriageway of the M5 (the ‘Y’ loop);

“the works” mean installation of a new concrete barrier, removal of existing barrier, reinstatement of road markings and studs;

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 22.00 hours on Monday 16th March 2015 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to an article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

(c) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works.
