**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Hylands Park)
Regulations 2015**

Made - - - - - *14th May 2015*

Coming into force - - - - - *21st August 2015*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Hylands Park near Chelmsford, Essex by reason of the intended gathering of a large number of persons at the V2015 Festival which is scheduled to take place there during the period from 21st to 24th August 2015.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Hylands Park) Regulations 2015 and come into force on 21st August 2015.

Interpretation

2. The times mentioned in regulation 3(1) are Co-ordinated Universal Time(b).

Restricted airspace

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), during the period beginning with 0700 hours on 21st August and ending at 1300 hours on 24th August 2015, no aircraft is to fly below 3,500 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by a circle having a radius of 1.5 nautical miles whose centre is at 514246N 0002557E.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft—

- (a) being operated by or on behalf of the National Police Air Service,
- (b) being operated by or on behalf of the Helicopter Emergency Medical Services, or
- (c) flying with the permission of Chief Inspector Jon Hayter or Superintendent Glenn Maleary of Essex Police.

(a) S.I. 2009/3015, to which there are amendments that are not relevant to these Regulations.
(b) In these Regulations Co-ordinated Universal Time (UTC) is one hour behind British Summer Time (BST).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Hylands Park near Chelmsford, Essex, by reason of the V2015 Festival that is scheduled to take place there from 21st to 24th August 2015. A large gathering of people will attend this event on each day; accordingly the Civil Aviation Authority's Safety and Airspace Regulation Group considers that flying should be restricted in the vicinity of the displays for reasons of public safety and security. This has been agreed with the Department for Transport.

The times mentioned in regulation 3(1) are Universal Co-ordinated Time (UTC), which for the purpose of these Regulations is one hour behind British Summer Time.
