**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Overton)
Regulations 2015**

Made - - - - *8th June 2015*

Coming into force - - *28th August 2015*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Overton, Hampshire by reason of flying displays at the CarFest South festival that is scheduled to take place there during the period from 28th to 30th August 2015.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009^(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Overton) Regulations 2015 and come into force on 28th August 2015.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3(1) all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time^(b).

Restricted airspace

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), between 1100 hours and 1330 hours on each day beginning with 28th and ending on 30th August 2015 no aircraft is to fly below 3,000 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by a circle having a radius of 1.5 nautical miles whose centre is at 511325N 0011500W.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying with the permission of the flying display director at CarFest South 2015.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Overton, Hampshire, during air displays for the general public that are scheduled to take place there during the CarFest South festival between 28th and 30th August 2015. A large number of aircraft will be involved in high energy manoeuvres during the displays. Accordingly, the Civil Aviation Authority's Safety and Airspace Regulation Group considers that flying should be restricted in the vicinity of the displays for reasons of public safety. This has been agreed with the Department for Transport.

The times mentioned in regulation 3(1) are Universal Co-ordinated Time (UTC), which for the purpose of these Regulations is one hour behind British Summer Time.

Full details of the Statutory Instrument will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
